This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.

- 2. By means of this writ petition, petitioner wants to expedite his application 7C2 for temporary injunction in Original Suit No.55 of 2024, filed under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of CPC r/w Section 151 of CPC, bearing Paper No.7C2, pending in the court of learned Civil Judge, Laksar, Haridwar.
- 3. It is case of the petitioner that the petitioner wants the aforesaid application 7C2 to be decided in a time bound manner, which was filed for temporary injunction against the respondents under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of CPC r/w Section 151 of CPC, bearing Paper No.7C2, before the learned Civil Judge, Laksar, Haridwar on or before the next date fixed in the trial, i.e., 11.11.2024. Petitioner/Plaintiff submitted that he moved aforesaid application on 19.03.2024 and the same is still pending. Objections have already been filed by the respondent-defendant.
- 4. In this view of the matter, a direction can be issued to the trial court to decide the said application expeditiously.
- 5. In this view of the matter, the writ petition is partly allowed. Learned Civil Judge Laksar, Haridwar is directed to decide application of the petitioner under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 CPC r/w Section 151 of CPC bearing Paper No.7C2, moved by the



petitioner, expeditiously within a period of one month from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
