- 1. This is an Application filed on behalf of the Petitioner to recall the order dated 05.09.2023 and for restoration of the Writ Petition.

- 4. Accordingly, the Application is allowed and the Writ Petition is restored.

- 9. It is clarified that this order is being passed without prejudice to the rights and contentions of both the parties.
