1. Heard Sri V.K. Srivastava, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

2. The instant petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking following reliefs:

*"i. Direct the opposite party no. 1 to decide the Claim Petition No. 0003 of 2023 (Rajendra son of Chauthi Prasad and others Vs. State of UP and another), pending before the Opposite Party No.1, expeditiously, within time stipulated by this Hon'ble Court.*

*ii. Issue such other order or direction as may be deemed just and proper under the facts and circumstances of the case.*

*Allow this petition with substantial costs to the petitioner."*

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner had filed a Claim Petition No. 0003 of 2023 (Rajendra S/o Chauthi Prasad and others Vs. State of U.P. and Anr.) before the learned State Public Services Tribunal, Lucknow in the year 2023. It has further been argued that the aforesaid claim petition is pending since year 2023 and has not been decided.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that due to pendency of the aforesaid claim petition, petitioner is facing harassment.

5. Learned Standing Counsel appearing for the State does not have any objection if this Court provides fixed time frame for disposal of the claim petition in question.

6. I have considered the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the parties and I find that the claim petition had been filed in the year 2023 and is pending before the learned Tribunal.

7. In view of the aforesaid, this petition is ***disposed of*** with a direction to Respondent No. 1 to expedite the hearing of the Claim Petition No. 0003 of 2023 (Rajendra S/o Chauthi Prasad and others Vs. State of U.P. and Anr.) and decide it expeditiously preferably within a period of eight months from the date of service of certified copy of this order.
